[WALT: Wildlife and Land Trusts](#) – The WALT: Wildlife and Land Trusts tool is a one-stop-shop for land trusts to navigate federal programs, find the right fit for their needs, and find contact information for the appropriate agency staff.

[Inflation Reduction Act Tracker](#) – The Environmental Defense Fund partnered with Columbia Law School’s Sabin Center for Climate Change Law to create a free database and progress tracker for all climate change-related provisions in the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), along with valuable information about programs, protections, incentives, and tax credits. The innovative tool provides users with: A searchable database of provisions by federal agency; Reliable tracking that records actions taken by agencies to implement provisions; Regular site maintenance to reflect up-to-date IRA implementations.
